A delightful and extremely well presented 2 double bedroom semi detached property backing onto open fields and enjoying superb countryside views from the first floor rear aspect, all situated in the popular village of Tatworth, nr Chard. The property comprises; entrance/conservatory, fitted kitchen, separate dining room, sitting room with attractive fireplace and multi-fuel burner and a first floor 4 piece white bathroom suite. Further benefits from double glazing, gas fired heating, enclosed well maintained garden and an off street parking space for a small vehicles.



Entrance

The main entrance is accessed via a timber pedestrian gate heading the path leading to the sliding patio door opening to:

Entrance/Conservatory: 8' 6" x 7' 4" (2.59m x 2.24m)

With double glazed windows to the rear and side aspects, additional door opening to the rear, tiled flooring and power points. Door to:

Kitchen: 11' 9" x 7' 10" (3.58m x 2.39m)

Fitted with a range of wood effect wall and base units, rolled edge worktops over and all complemented by tiled splash-backs. Inset porcelain one and half bowl and drainer with mixer tap over. Built-in oven with a Zanussi ceramic hob and extractor over. Space and plumbing for a washing machine and space for an upright fridge/freezer. Double glazed window to the rear aspect, wall mounted Vaillant gas fired boiler, single panel radiator, tiled flooring and an exposed timber beam.

Dining Room: 11' 1" x 9' 7" (3.37m x 2.91m)

Double glazed window to the front aspect, double panel radiator, two wall-light points and exposed timber beams. Built-in under-stairs storage cupboard. Opening to:

Sitting Room: 11' 0" x 10' 4" (3.35m x 3.15m)

Attractive stone built fireplace with a wood mantle and inset Stoves multi-fuel burner. Double glazed window to the front aspect with window seat feature, single panel radiator, TV and telephone points, four wall-light points. Stairs rise to:

First Floor Landing

With access to all first floor rooms and a smoke detector.

Bedroom 1: 11' 2" x 10' 3" (3.41m x 3.12m)

Double glazed window to the front aspect, single panel radiator and a telephone point. Built-in single wardrobe.

Bedroom 2: 11' 9" x 7' 9" (3.59m x 2.37m)

Double glazed window to the rear aspect enjoying superb views over open fields and a single panel radiator.

Bathroom: 12' 0" x 6' 4" (3.65m x 1.93m)

Fitted with a modern white four piece suite comprising; square cubicle with a glass screen, door and wall mounted thermostatic shower with rainfall head over. Panel bath with taps over. Wash hand basin and pedestal with tap over. Low level WC. Obscure double glazed window to the front aspect, part tiled walls, laminate flooring, extractor, single panel radiator and a chrome ladder style heated towel rail. Access to the roof void with light and power connected.

Outside

The property backs onto open fields and enjoys superb views over open fields from the rear aspect first floor. An off street parking space for a small vehicle heads the entrance gate opening to:

The main garden and entrance is to the side aspect. A gravel path with timber pergola over leads to the steps down to the entrance/conservatory and is flanked on either side by a feature ornamental pond and small lawn area. Beds are filled with a good variety of mature plants. A hardstanding area to the rear of the property is currently used as storage for refuse bins and logs. Outside water tap. All enclosed by timber fencing and hedges.
