Located towards the end of an exclusive close with good access to the town centre and Bicester Village rail station. No onward chain. Entering into the reception hall, the cloakroom is to your right and the dining room next to it with a bay window to the front. The kitchen is also on your right and is fitted with modern wall and base units opening to the utility room with a door to the garden. To your left off the hall is a spacious dual aspect sitting room with French doors out to the garden. Upstairs is a family bathroom, four double bedrooms and an ensuite and fitted wardrobes to the main bedroom. There are also fitted wardrobes to the second bedroom. Outside the front garden has flower beds and is flanked by a driveway providing parking for two cars and access to the single garage. The rear garden offers a good degree of privacy with a patio, artificial lawn, flower beds and continues to the side of the house where there is a large shed.
