Three Bedroom End-Terraced House With Off-Road Parking

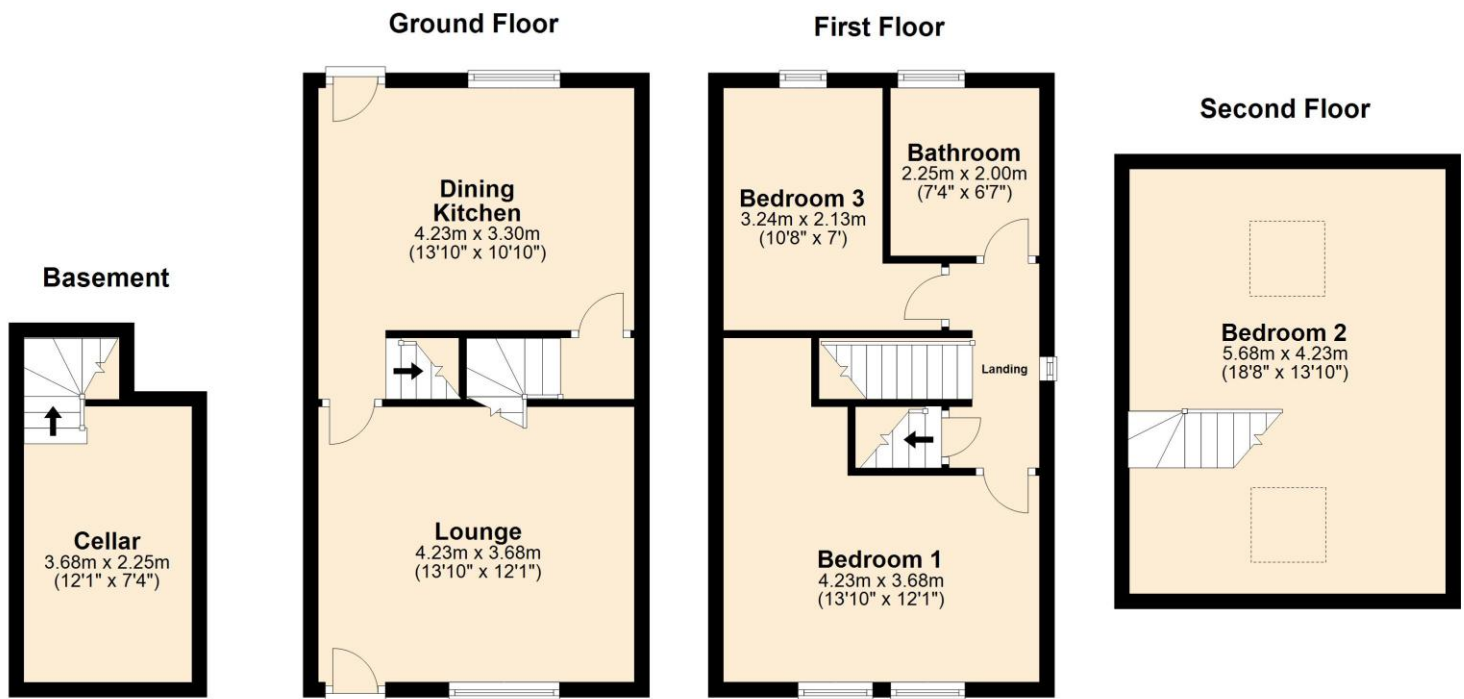
