To the front of the property, immaculately kept lawn gardens provide an inviting space for socialising and enjoying the tranquil surroundings.

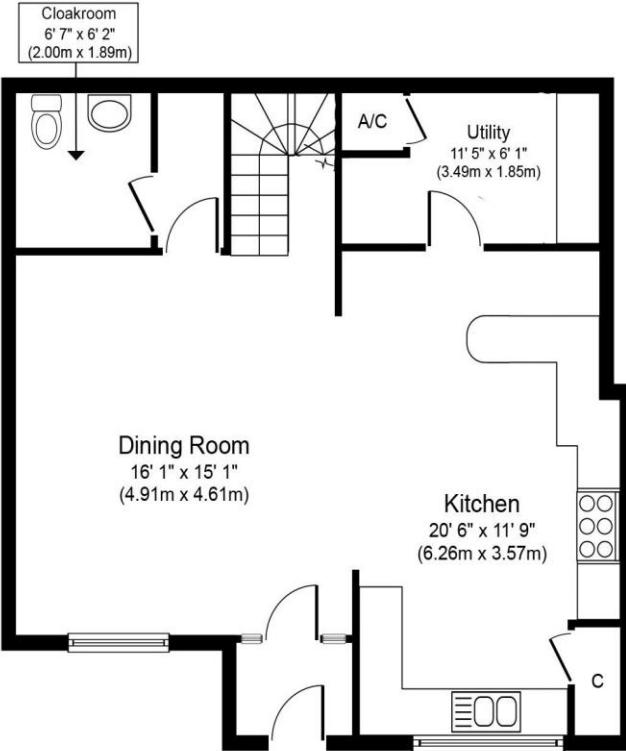

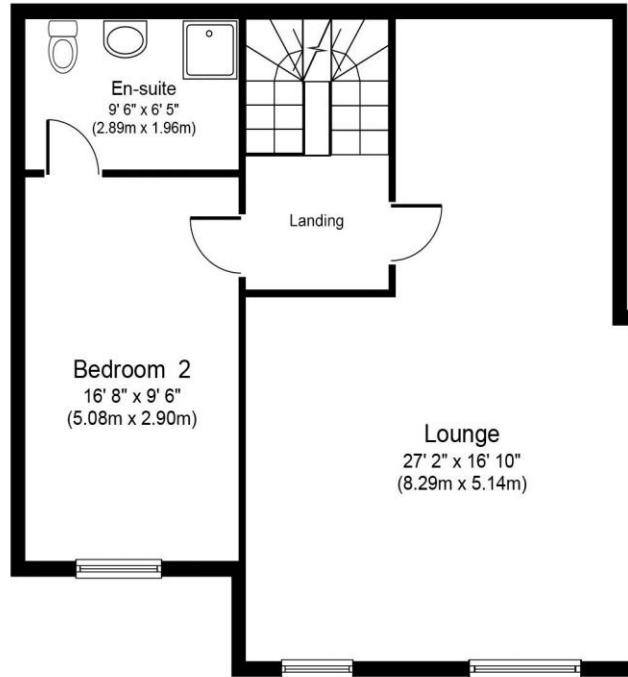




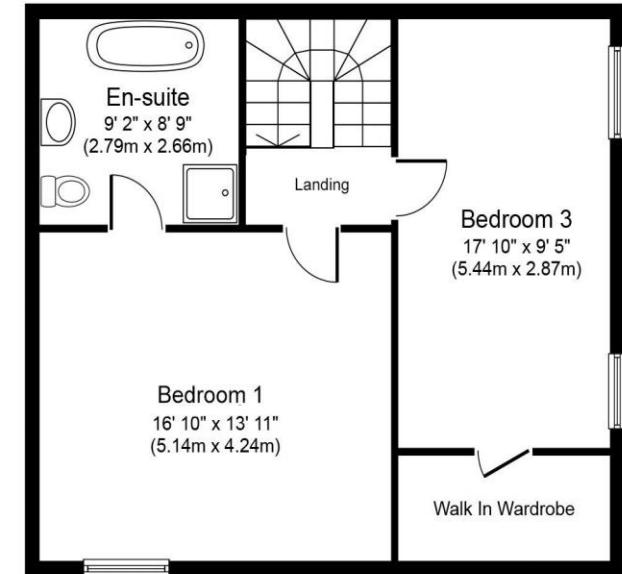
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Ground Floor

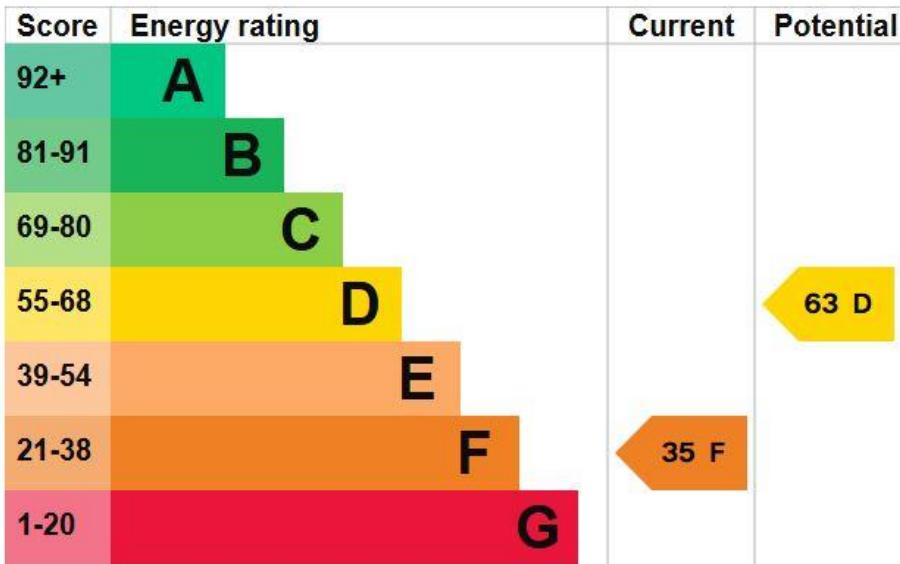


First Floor

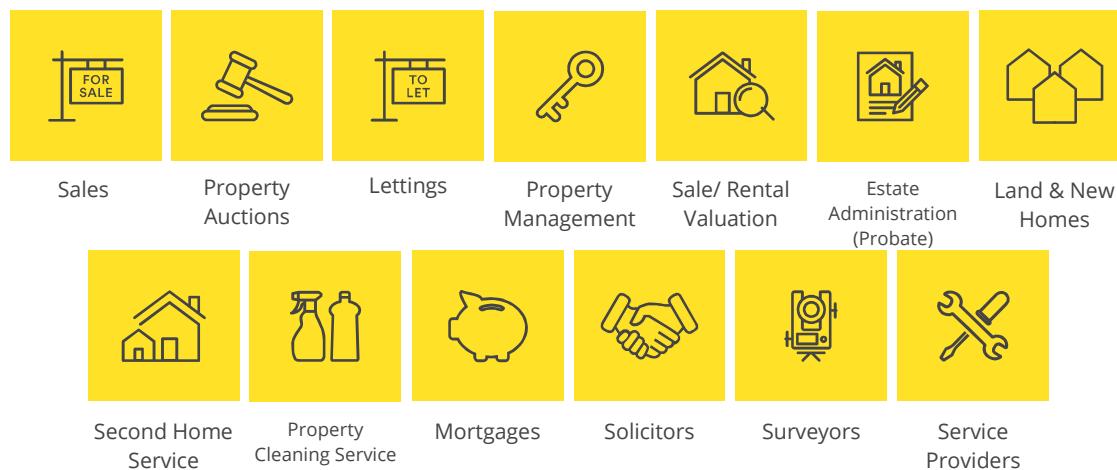
Second Floor
