



Window to rear and fitted with a range of wall and base units with roll top work surfaces over incorporating a single drainer stainless steel sink unit, washing machine, cooker and fridge freezer to remain.

## Bedroom One

Window to rear, storage heater, wall light point, fitted wardrobes.

## Bathroom/ W.C

Fitted with a suite comprising low flush w.c, vanity wash hand basin with cupboard below, panel enclosed bath with separate shower over, fully tiled walls around bath, half tiled walls, panel heater.


